



At the end of Year 4, I will know and remember...

**Autumn 1 Judaism** Enquiry: How do Jewish beliefs, teachings and stories impact on daily life?

I can discuss why I would choose to follow an instruction not to eat certain foods, whom I would listen to and why.

I can describe some of the things Jews do to show how their beliefs and respect for God impacts on their daily life.

I can start to identify how it might feel to keep Kashrut.

**Autumn 2 Christianity** Enquiry: What is the most significant part of the Nativity story for Christians today?

I can say what I think about the Christian belief in Jesus as the incarnation of God and explain what Christmas time means to me.

I can describe some of the symbolism of Christmas and explain a Christian belief about Jesus.

I can consider what might be significant for a Christian about the Nativity story and what it tells them about Jesus.

**Spring 1 Humanism** Enquiry: What motivates Humanists to lead good lives?

I can explain some actions a Humanist might take to lead a good life.

I can explain some things that Humanists might believe.

I can explain how Humanists might act in their daily lives.

**Spring 2 Christianity** - Enquiry: Is forgiveness always possible for Christians?

I can say whether I think showing forgiveness might be important.

I can describe what a Christian might learn about forgiveness from a Bible text.

I can show an understanding of how Christians might believe God can help them show forgiveness.

**Summer 1 Judaism** Enquiry: How does celebrating Shavuot help Jewish children feel closer to God?

I can reflect on celebrations and say why they are special

I recall the main story of Shavuot and talk about some of the key beliefs and practices

I can reflect on the Shavuot festival and explain how some aspects may help a Jewish child feel closer to God.

**Summer 2 Christianity** Enquiry: Do people need to go to church to show they are Christians?

I can explain some of the feelings about a special place gives me and suggest why they exist

I can describe some of the ways Christians use Churches to worship and pray or celebrate important events and services such as Baptisms and Holy Communion

I can understand why a Church may have an impact on a Christian.
