

mammal	an animal that feeds milk to its babies
	(They have fur or hair.)
bird	an animal that has feathers, wings and a beak
	(It lays eggs.)
reptile	a cold blooded animal that has scales
	(It lays eggs.)
fish	a cold-blooded animal that lives in water
	(Most have gills. Many lay eggs.)
amphibian	an animal that can live in water and on land
	(They lay eggs in the water.)
dinosaurs	a group of animals that lived millions of years ago before humans were around (They were reptiles.)
carnivore	a meat eater
herbivore	a plant eater
omnivore	an animal that eats both meat and plants
