Key Word	Meaning
<b>pet</b>	an animal that is cared for by its owner
<b>mammal</b>	an animal that feeds milk to its babies (They have fur or hair.)
<b>bird</b>	an animal that has feathers, wings and a beak (It lays eggs.)
<b>reptile</b>	a cold blooded animal that has scales (It lays eggs.)
<b>fish</b>	a cold-blooded animal that lives in water (Most have gills. Many lay eggs.)
<b>amphibian</b>	an animal that can live in water and on land (They lay eggs in the water.)
<b>dinosaurs</b>	a group of animals that lived millions of years ago before humans were around (They were reptiles.)
<b>carnivore</b>	a meat eater
<b>herbivore</b>	a plant eater
<b>omnivore</b>	an animal that eats both meat and plants
