Unison



Keyboard- a set of keys on a piano or similar musical instrument.

Pentatonic Scale- A pentatonic scale is a musical scale with five notes per octave

Unison- In music, unison refers to two or more musical parts (voices or instruments) playing or singing the same note or melody at the same time, regardless of the octave

Understanding Music

Tempo:	Andante — at a walking pace (97bpm)
Time signature:	2/4 — there are two crotchet beats in a bar
Key signature:	F major — there is one flat in the key signature (b)
Rhythmic patterns using:	Minims, dotted crotchets, crotchets, quavers and semiquavers

Improvise Together

Time signature:	4/4
Key signature:	C major
Notes:	C, D, E, G, A (C pentatonic)
